

Level 3 Acceptance Requirements

The Pittsfield Assembly Level 3 program in itself is to be thought of as two separate entities; the internship program and the school of ministry. Below are the criteria that students must meet to enroll in the respective programs.

Level 3 Internship Students must:

- Show evidence of a divine call to a specific area of ministry.
- Have a willingness to learn and serve in other ministry areas besides their primary ministry.
- Sign off and adhere to the Level 3 Internship policy agreement.

Level 3 School of Ministry Students must:

- Show evidence of a divine call to a specific area of ministry.
- Have a willingness to learn and serve in other ministry areas besides their primary ministry.
- Sign off and adhere to the Level 3 School of Ministry policy agreement.
- Make a \$100 housing damage deposit (refundable upon inspection at year's end)
- Sign a tuition payment agreement. (Contact us with any questions.)
- If a student is local and right out of high school or attends Pittsfield Assembly, it will be required that the student first complete the Focus 1 (Rockford) gap year program before enrolling in the Level 3 program. (See <u>focusone.com</u> for more info.)
- Students who are not local and do not attend Pittsfield Assembly will be required to have at least one year of experience at a college or a job and a letter of recommendation from their pastor.

Additional criteria may be deemed necessary and may be made on a case-by-case basis at the discretion of the Pittsfield Assembly pastoral staff.
